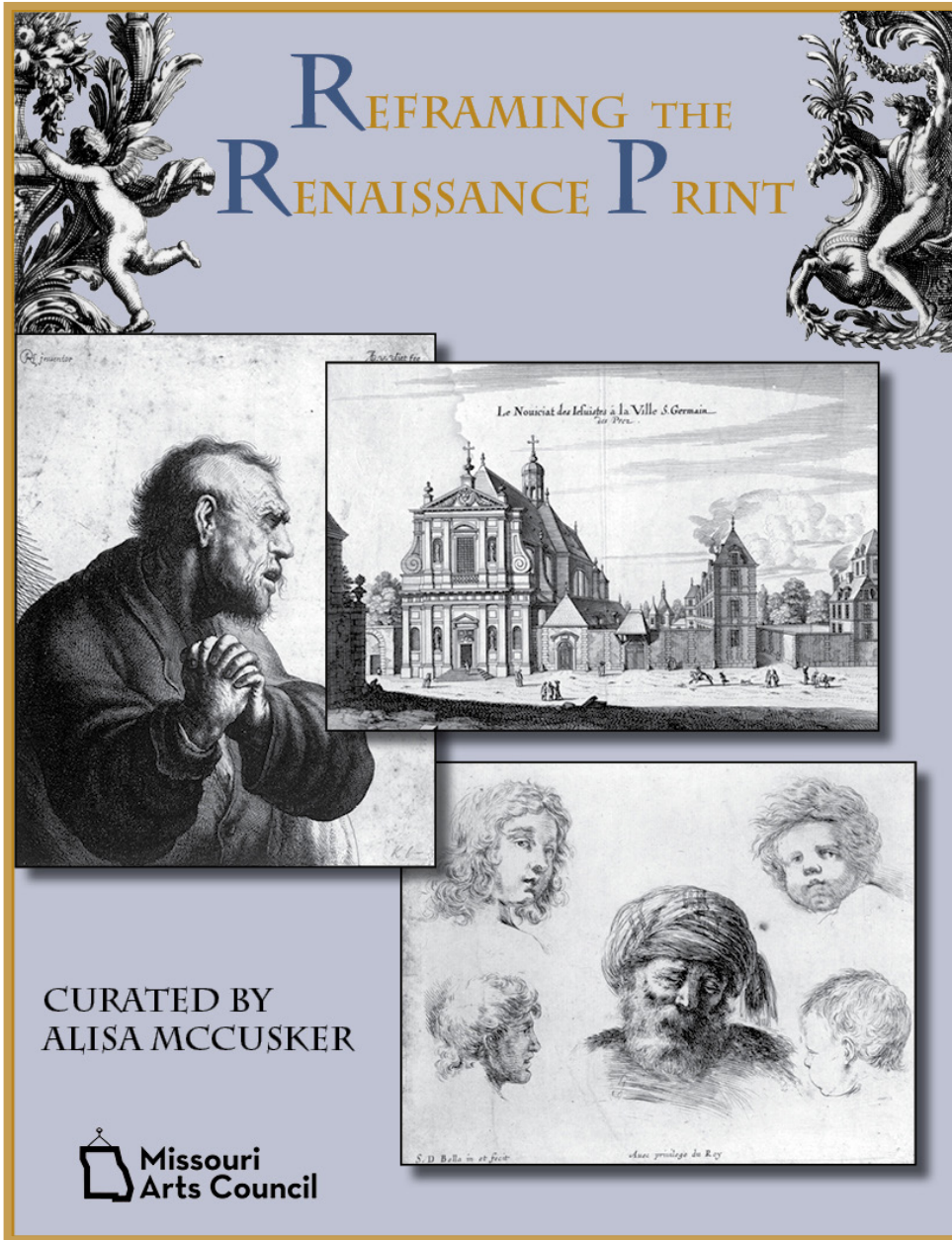




MUSEUM ONLINE EXHIBITION
